ISSUES RAISED 2009 MEETING

ISSUES RAISED 2009 MEETING	
1	Camp St/North St dangerous corner (investigate safety: on left before corner a narrow strip that drops down to creek; investigate guardrail near batter and power pole)
2	Bywong St – investigate development as a through road
3	Unsealed section of Bywong St needs further maintenance attention
4	Landscape planning; watercourse wetland construction; vehicle barriers at oval (com to advise)
5	Tallagandra Lane investigation
6	Victoria East – request to be upgraded to bitumen surface (retain trees if possible)
7	Mulligans Flat Road upgrade to bitumen surface
8	Investigate intersection Mulligans Flat Rd & Sutton Rd – visibility to south
9	No through Road Sign on Browns Road
10	Valley Views be distributed with the Sutton Chatter as still not being received by many residents
11	Noxious weeds – Tallagandra Lane area Serrated tussock, scotch thistle, St John's Wort

Yass Valley Council will be visiting villages in the Local Government Area during February and March to determine issues that should be addressed in the Management Plan for 2009/2010 – 2011/2012.

After this initial community consultation, we will be drafting the Management Plan, seeking Council's approval on the 'Draft Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 and placing it on public exhibition for a period of 28 days (15 May 2009 – 12 June 2009). All residents of the Yass Valley LGA will still have the opportunity to comment on the Plan whilst it is on public exhibition.

The Final Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 will be presented to Council at its meeting to be held on 24 June 2009.
