ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION IN THE 2009/10 MANAGEMENT PLAN – M’BATEMAN

ISSUES RAISED 2009 MEETING	
1	Request for focus on the implementation of the Murrumbateman Recreation Master Plan (property acquisition and master planning), pedestrian/cycle/horse greenways to link the estates with the Recreation Ground, improve facilities at Nirta Drive Common, develop playground and carpark in Hercules Street
2	Pedestrian Safety at the intersection Barton Highway / Murrumbateman Road - separate footbridge requested (also in 07/08 submission)
3	Completion of 08/09 Murrumbateman projects: South St, Directional Signs, Jones Park Map, Hercules St Playground and carpark
4	Horse Rink area – request for heavy duty shade mesh on southern side of tennis courts to restrict dust from blowing onto courts
5	Remove the light industrial category from the village zoning and creation of a separate light industry zone
5	Valley Views – publish information on the status of the new bore & investigate distribution (not all residents are receiving a copy)
6	An additional rubbish bin in East St (near Springers Rest)
7	Provide advice on grass cutting schedule/standards

ISSUES RAISED 2009 MEETING	
8	External lighting on amenities block is not sufficient
9	Improve approach to Jones Park bridge
10	Update of Civic Guide to show all streets
11	Cycleway maintenance needs to be increased to prevent grass growing over pathway
12	Cycleway – investigate the installation of bollards to prevent tractors using path (Isabel to South)
13	Provision of a quarterly status report on project to the Progress Association for inclusion on their website

5. CONCLUSION

Yass Valley Council will be visiting villages in the Local Government Area during February and March to determine issues that should be addressed in the Management Plan for 2009/2010 – 2011/2012.

After this initial community consultation, we will be drafting the Management Plan, seeking Council's approval on the 'Draft Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 and placing it on public exhibition for a period of 28 days (15 May 2009 – 12 June 2009). All residents of the Yass Valley LGA will still have the opportunity to comment on the Plan whilst it is on public exhibition.

The Final Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 will be presented to Council at its meeting to be held on 24 June 2009.
