4	Internal painting of hall – request for provision of paint
5	Tennis practice wall
6	Tennis club liability insurance
7	Spoon drain at tennis courts can get very slippery – request to investigate options
8	Plan of cemetery – request for copy of the plan
9	Link next years meeting with the Ag Bureau meeting on last Tuesday in February 7pm
10	Burrinjuck Road – dangerous tree (10km near “Lindlee” address 999)
11	Recreation Ground – request for garbage bins to be checked every week

15	Noxious Weeds – Serrated Tussock on Burrinjuck Rd, Blackberries at Connors Ck and Paterson Curse in highway median
16	Black Range Road – creek/ road stabilisation
17	Hall with 24hr exit lights – provide contact regarding BCA standards
18	Investigate rural permits for Illalong Road

## CONCLUSION

Yass Valley Council will be visiting villages in the Local Government Area during February and March to determine issues that should be addressed in the Management Plan for 2009/2010 – 2011/2012.

After this initial community consultation, we will be drafting the Management Plan, seeking Council's approval on the 'Draft Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 and placing it on public exhibition for a period of 28 days (15 May 2009 – 12 June 2009). All residents of the Yass Valley LGA will still have the opportunity to comment on the Plan whilst it is on public exhibition.

The Final Management Plan – 2009/2010 – 2011/2012 will be presented to Council at its meeting to be held on 24 June 2009.
