

Title: WASTE MANAGEMENT WM-POL-3

1. OBJECTIVE

To outline the principles and goals under which Council strategies and procedures for managing waste will operate.

2. DEFINITION

Solid Waste - any solid material that is surplus to, or unwanted from any industrial, commercial, domestic or other activity, whether or not of value.

3. PRINCIPLES AND GOALS

- 3.1 Promote waste prevention including waste avoidance and waste reduction.
- 3.2 Aim to increase recycling including reuse, reprocessing and waste utilisation.
- 3.3 Recognise disposal as a last resort.
- 3.4 Recognise that waste generators have responsibility for the fate of their waste until correct waste management or disposal is assured.
- 3.5 Apply user pays and polluter pays principles to waste management.
- 3.6 Develop and maintain a Waste Management Strategy that reflects current practices and identifies future directions for Yass Valley Council.
- 3.7 Promote effective commercial waste minimisation practices.
- 3.8 Eliminate landfills within the Local Government area of Yass Valley Council.
- 3.9 Increase integration with regional strategies and the use of regional facilities.
- 3.10 Minimise or avoid adverse effects on the environment.
