



- Ref 0.03 Ensure proposals protect the cultural landscape and heritage values of the Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal community
- Ref 2.18a - Fitzroy & Montem Street Planting - Commission detail design for street trees in Fitzroy Street using the Stockholm planting method within the road pavement and extending the community garden around Montem Street bus stop to include a seat, bike rack to improve town presentation (design work by consultant)
- Ref 2.18b - Montem Street Planting - Extend community garden around Montem Street bus stop and include installation of a seat and bike rack to improve town presentation (construction budget)
- Ref 1.13 Provide interpretive signage at Railway Station - seek co-operation/funding from Transport for NSW (design & construction budget)
- Ref 0.25 Council to discuss with Railway Manager the long-term use and maintenance of the iconic railway terminus to provide community benefit
- Ref 2.18c - Install street trees in Montem Street using the Stockholm planting method within the road pavement (construction budget)
- Ref 1.04 Install bus shelter on Montem Street, near the Hotel, or other agreed location
- Ref 0.27 Commission a town-wide Public Art Plan to optimise active travel and tourism opportunities

- Ref 0.26 Council to investigate with TfNSW re-extending and widening the slip lane, north bound, southern entrance to Bowning to improve safety
- Ref 0.24 Install new village name entry signage at each of the village approaches, including removal of signage, landscaping and weed removal. (Signage design finalised separately.)
- Ref 1.16 Provide entrance signage for Recreation Ground
- Ref 0.20 Ensure the Masterplan for the Recreation Ground addresses improvements for the playground, connectivity to the village, infrastructure and amenity improvements and provision of shade
- Ref 0.23 Develop a maintenance agreement between Council and Bowning Progress Association which addresses insurances, risk management and WHS requirements
- Ref 0.11 Commission a village-wide Wayfinding and Interpretive Signage Plan to optimise active travel, tourism and trail opportunities
