The Australian Drinking Water Guidelines (ADWG) include two types of measures:

- a health-related guideline value, which is the concentration or measure of a water quality
 characteristic that, based on present knowledge, does not result in any significant risk to the health
 of the consumer over a lifetime of consumption; and
- an aesthetic guideline value, which is the concentration or measure of a water quality characteristic that is associated with acceptability of water to the consumer; for example, appearance, taste, and odour.ⁱ

Yass Valley Council reports both Guideline measures in the interests of transparent governance.
